



Silo Cabana Reservation Policies

- Reservations can be made up to 3 months in advance and require payment in full.
- Once reservations are confirmed, cancellations made within 72 hours of the reservation are not eligible for a refund.
- If Highland Brewing determines weather would prohibit an outdoor reservation, the reservation will be moved inside, and no refund will be provided.
- Cabana access begins and ends at your designated reservation time.
- Each Cabana has a dedicated deck with capacity for up to 24 guests. The grassy area around the Silo Cabanas is open to other Highland guests in the Meadow. Additional tables and chairs cannot be set up outside the Cabana deck.
- Hanging, sitting, and standing on the Cabana railing around is not permitted.
- Any children visiting Highland Brewing must be accompanied by an adult and within view *at all times*.
- Dogs must be leashed and under guardian control *at all times*.
- Highland will provide a dedicated reservation sign for each Silo Cabana that includes Guest Name (as booked in the reservation) and reservation time. Guests reserving the Silo Cabanas are allowed to bring one additional sign (11 x 17 - guest to provide) to use in the Cabana.
- Highland Brewing is a family-friendly establishment. Any decor, including the guest provided signage, cannot include profanity, lewd comments or any language or imagery that Highland deems inappropriate. Highland reserves the right to take down any signage and décor at our discretion.
- Balloons and flags are not permitted.
- Amplified music and/or microphones are not permitted to be used during your reservation.
- Vending and solicitation are strictly *prohibited*.
- Outside beverages, including non-alcoholic and alcoholic drinks, are strictly prohibited.
- Groups violating any of Highland's reservation policies may be asked to leave the premises and the reservation fee will not be refunded.
